“God’s Story, Promise, Reign: Covenant and Kingdom”

1. In what ways have you noticed the overuse of the word *covenant*? What are some other good theological words that get overused within the Christian community so that they lose their meaning?
2. How does understanding covenant as story help you in reading the Bible? By what other master narratives do we live our lives (e.g., the American story)? Do these stories come into conflict with the biblical story that owns us? If so, how?
3. What are some themes of the covenant story in the Old Testament? How do these themes find fulfillment in Jesus?
4. What do you think about the claim that the promise which God’s covenant makes is his promise of Jesus Christ extended to his people? How does that help us understand that salvation was the same in the Old Testament as it is in the New Testament?
5. How should thinking about God’s kingdom impact one’s Christian life?



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
