Questions for Lesson 6 - Wednesday, October 11

On Being Presbyterian by Dr. Sean Michael Lucas
“Gospel-Driven Presbyterian Worship”

1. Have you ever been in a church that has experienced a major conflict over worship style? How devastating was it to the witness and testimony of the church?
2. Does the regulative principle of worship limit the way in which we actually worship? What is something that you wish you could do in worship that is prohibited by the regulative principle? Have you ever thought about Leviticus 10 in relationship to contemporary discussions over worship?
3. Think about liberty of conscience as it relates to worship. How can churches use this idea to bind believers' consciences in an unbiblical way in worship? How can individuals use this idea as an objection in an unbiblical fashion in order to stymie worship of which they do not approve?
4. If you have your church's order of worship at hand, look at how the service is structured. Do you notice a two-way movement from God to his people and back to God? If not, what does your church's worship structure suggest about the congregation's view of God, human beings, and salvation?
5. What does renewal of your faith look like as you worship God? Is it an internal sense of strengthening? Is it a conscious claiming of God's promises made in Jesus? What is it?
